To be eligible, Bidders must fulfil the following minimum requirements:

1. Proof of registration with the Registrar of Companies in Zimbabwe;
2. Proof of Registration with CIFOZ, ZBCA, or Ministry of Public Works in category A (unlimited);
3. Proof of registration with the Zimbabwe Revenue Authority;
4. Proof of completed construction projects with a combined value of at least USD10million in the last 10 years;
5. Audited financial statements for the past 3 years; and
6. Letter of intent from a Bank to provide performance bond.

Joint ventures with international construction companies will be encouraged. A compulsory tender briefing session will be held at 10h00 on Friday, 3 November 2017 only for registered Bidders. Completed RFQ proposals must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked with the relevant Bid number and Bid description and deposited in the Tender Box at Ernst & Young, Derry House, Corner Fife Street & 6th Avenue, Bulawayo by no later than **11:00am on Friday, 1 December 2017**. Late submissions will not be accepted. Preference will be given to locally based companies/consortia with at least 30% indigenous shareholding.
