## WATER CONNECTION PROCEDURE

Bulawayo City Council's Engineering Services Department has called upon residents of Bulawayo wishing to connect water to their new residential and business places to first pay for the inspection fee at their respective housing offices.

The Director of Engineering Services Mr Simela Dube said that the payment of the inspection fee at the various housing offices was done to ensure that the applicant had completed building their houses. Council does not effect any water connections before a house is completed and all the plumbing has been done.

Applicants are advised to collect application forms from the Water Enquiries Section at the Revenue Hall. All completed forms have to be submitted to 5<sup>th</sup> Floor Tower Block for a quotation that will include a list of materials required for the connection.

After payments have been made at the Revenue Hall, the applicants should make arrangements for water connection with the Bulawayo City Council's Water Connections Section located along 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Bulawayo.

Council is advising and encouraging residents to use water wisely in order to save water. The stipulated amount of water for Western suburbs is a daily consumption of 350 litres and Eastern suburbs have a limit of 400 litres of water.
